\* MATH 115 satisfies GE Area 2. For HOSP, take STAT 100, not MATH 115, to meet B2.

\*\*HOSP majors should take HOSP 200. ACCT, ASCM, & BSBA majors should take BUS 200. Students who change to HOSP after taking BUS 200 should take HOSP 200 as soon as possible. Students who take HOSP 200 and then change to another COB major should take BUS 200 as soon as possible. For example, take spring of sophomore year instead of WCL, and take WCL during junior or senior year.

\*\*\* ASCM are encouraged to take AGPS 128. AGPS 128 also satisfies Area 5C.

\*\*\*\* Students who take AGPS 128 to satisfy Area 5A also satisfy Area 5c and therefore can take any Area 5B here.

\*\*\*\*\* For HOSP, not a Major requirement.
