RISK MANAGEMENT POLICY

I. Introduction

Executive Order #715 regarding risk management from the Chancellor's Office delegates authority and responsibility to the campus president to implement campus risk management policies consistent with the California State University Risk Management Policy guidelines.

II. Policy

California State University, Monterey Bay has developed guidelines that comply with Executive Order 715. The Foundation of California State University, Monterey Bay (the "Foundation") hereby adopts the Campus Guidelines and Procedures on Risk Management.

III. Adoption and Review

The Foundation Board of Directors has adopted this Risk Management Policy, dated May 2012.

This Risk Management Policy will be reviewed ten years from its adoption date to determine its utility and appropriateness. If circumstances require, this policy may be evaluated before that time to ensure compliance with substantial organizational, financial, or physical change(s) at the Foundation or any change required by law or other governing policy.
