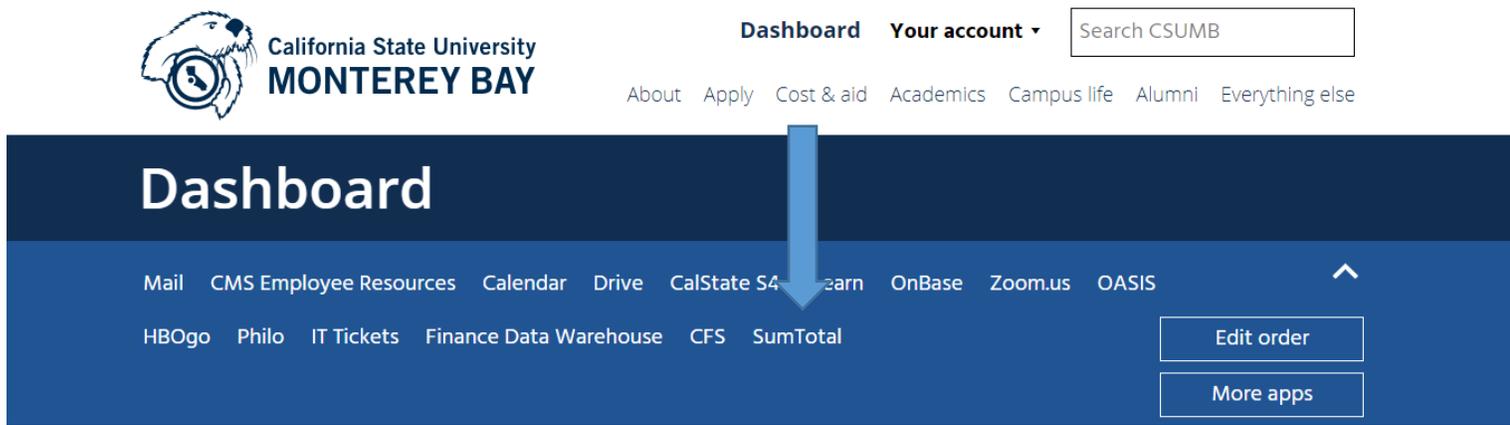
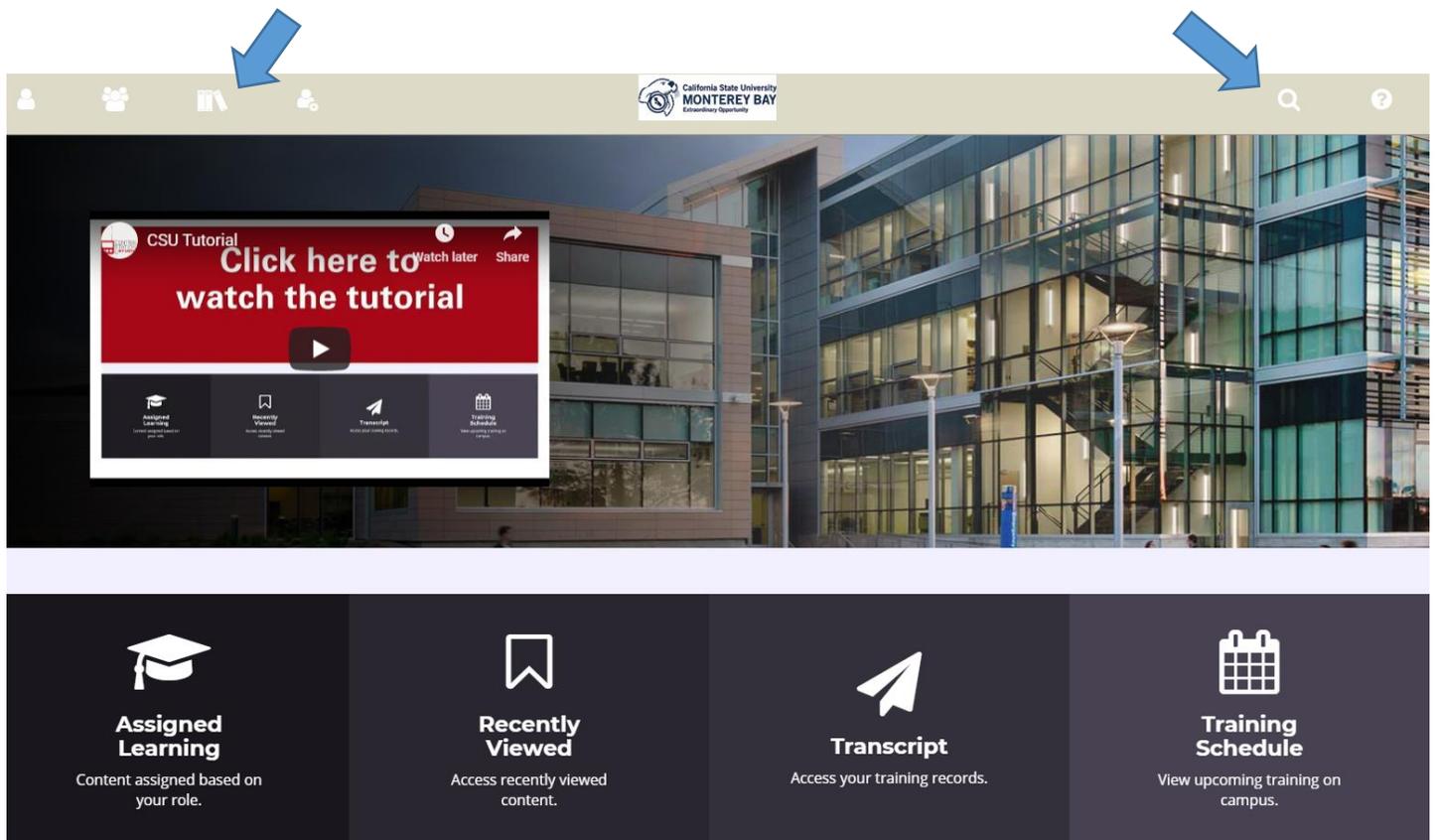


To login and self-assign Defensive Driving in SumTotal

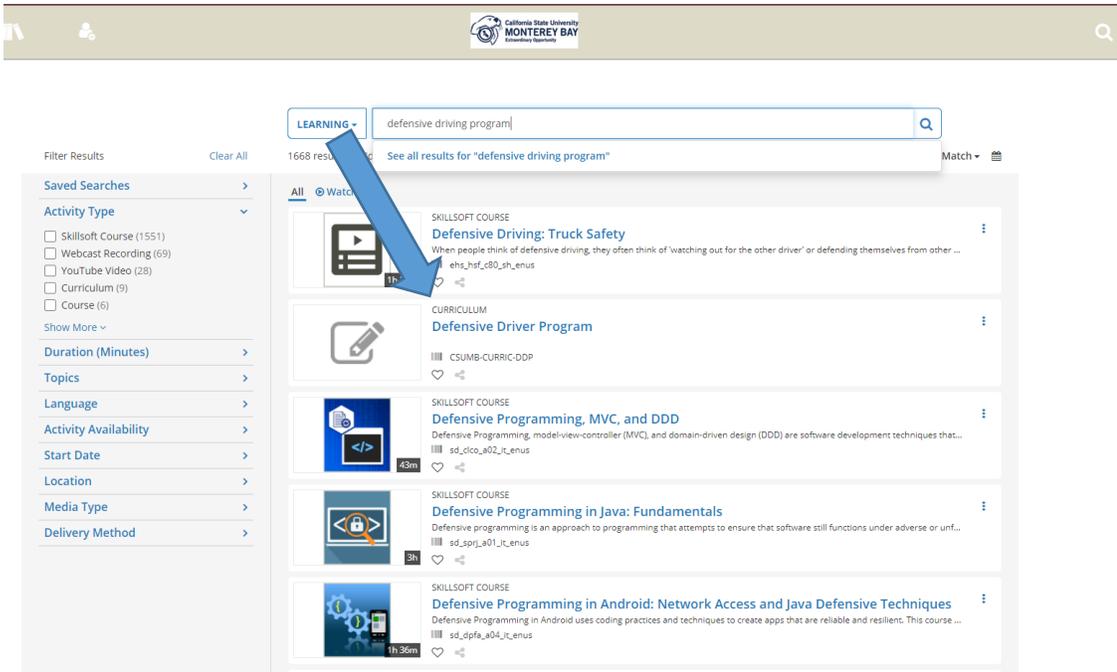
1. Access SumTotal via this Link https://csu.sumtotal.host/core/dash/home/Home_Monterey_Bay or through your CSUMB Dashboard--



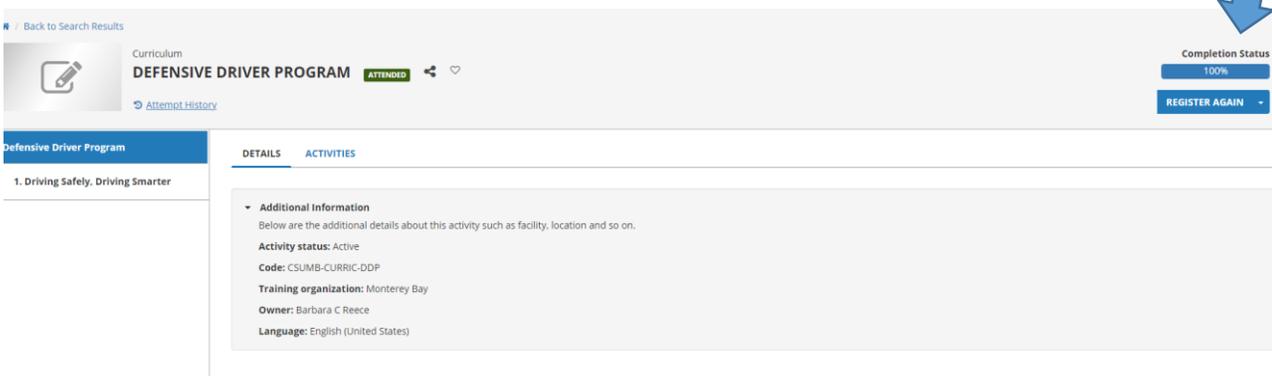
2. You can look up Defensive Driving (and 100s of other trainings) either in the Library Books icon, or under the Magnifying Glass icon.



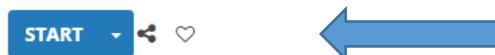
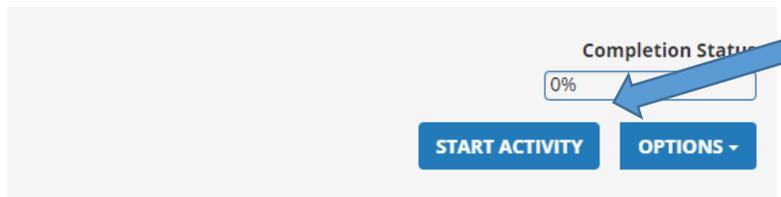
3. Make sure to select the correct training. Taking the Defensive Driving Truck Safety Course is not the same course as the CSUMB Defensive Driving Program Curriculum course.



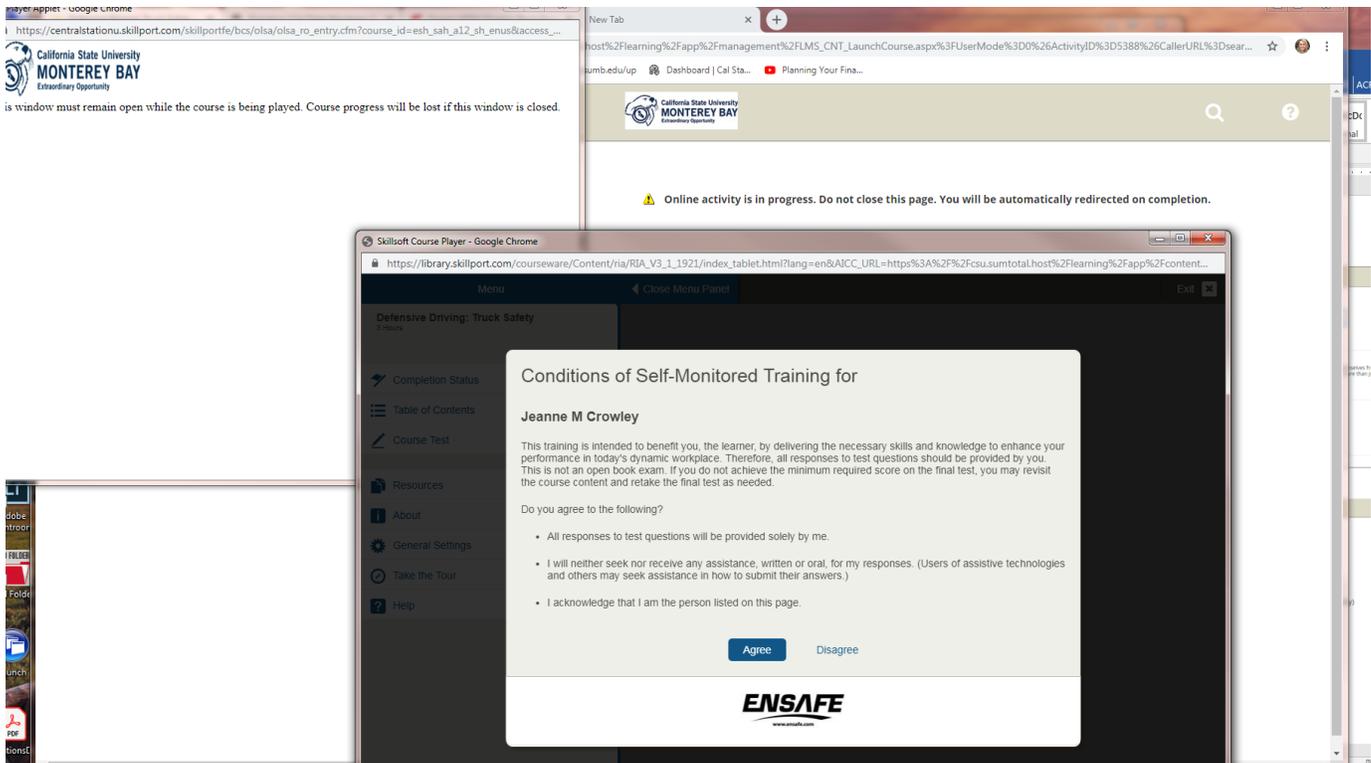
4. You will then need to **Register** or **Register Again** to the Registration Summary.



5. Once you are ready to begin, press the **START** Button to take you to the beginning of the course.



6. You will notice that several windows open. It is **important to keep them all open to ensure that your training stays linked to your profile in SumTotal in order to obtain credit for taking the course.**

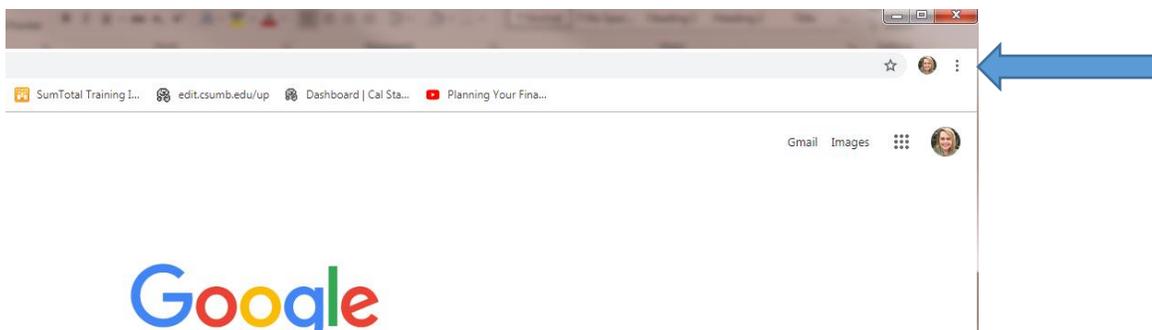


We also recommend saving a copy of your certification at the end just in case you have an issue with your training linking back to SumTotal

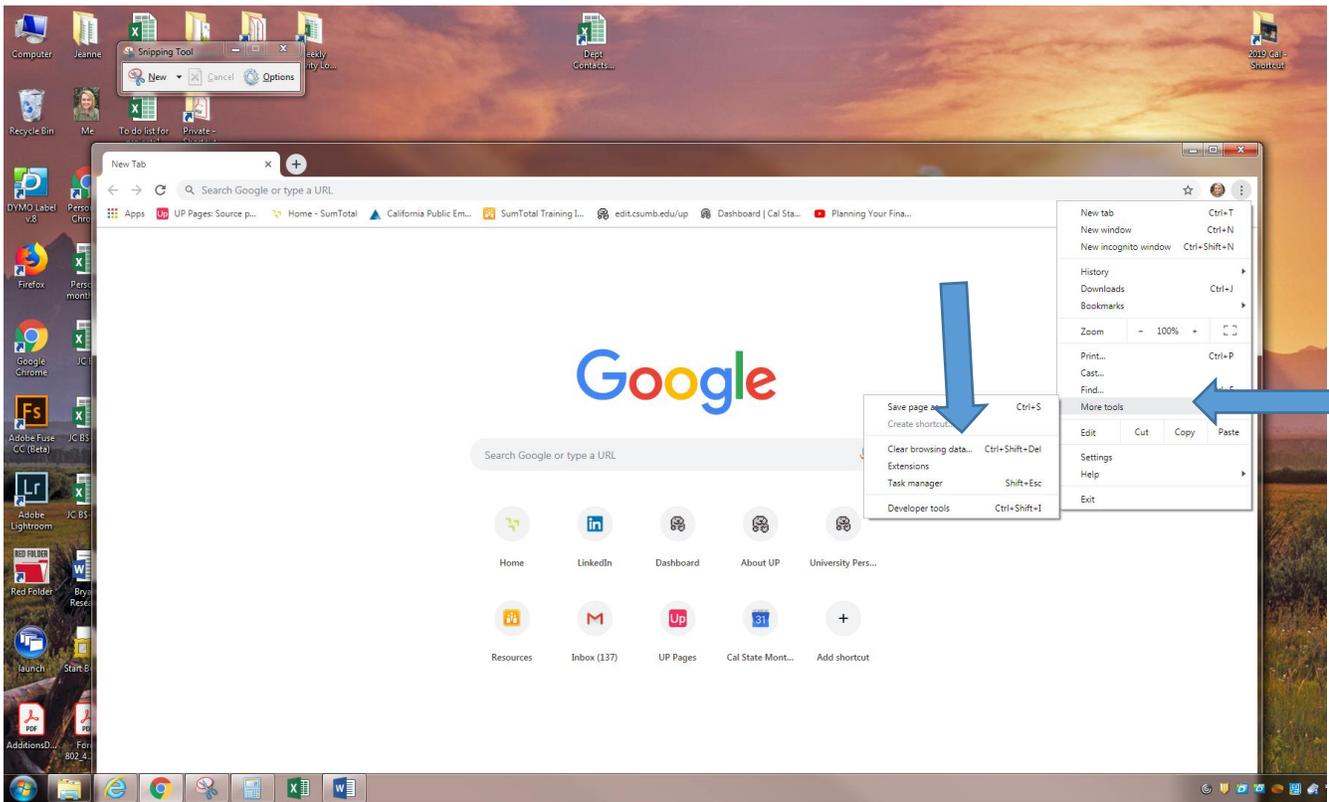
If you experience any issues with accessing your course please try the following immediate remedies—
