

## Business AS-T to Sustainable Hospitality & Tourism Management, B.S., Destination & Tourism Management Concentration 2-Year Transfer Pathway 2025-2026

This pathway assumes completion of AS-T in Business or major prerequisite courses including Macroeconomics, Microeconomics, Financial Accounting, Managerial Accounting, Business Law, Business Communication, Statistics, Finite Math (or Precalculus or Calculus), IGETC or CSU GE Certification. Students who have not completed these requirements prior to transfer will need to complete the missing requirements at either CSUMB or at a community college.
