

AA-T Global Studies to B.A. Global Studies Pathway 2025-2026

This pathway assumes that students have completed an AA for Transfer (AA-T) in Global Studies. Students who have transfer credit for GS 206 may enroll in GS 300 in their first semester.

Transfers who have not completed the AA-T or a course equivalent to GS 206 Intro to Globalization will need to complete GS 206 prior to enrolling in GS 300.
