Criteria for nomination:

Distinction in the Major for Exemplary Achievement is awarded to students who have best integrated the vision of ITCD into their learning and practices by demonstrating all of the following: (verified by the institute office)

- Achieved a cumulative grade-point average of at least 3.0 in CST classes. Calculation of the grade-point average for the purpose of this award does not include current semester grades.
- Receiving a degree (BS or MS) and eligible to participate in the graduation ceremony

And one of more of the following: (documented by nominating faculty)

- Participation and involvement as a student leader and positive agent of innovation and action, with demonstrated service back to the students and the institute.
- Served on one or more institute committees or special projects focused on the development of the ITCD mission, policies or practices.
- Demonstrated a pioneering spirit, characteristic of ITCD, by leaving a tangible, lasting legacy as a result of their student involvement.
- Overcome significant difficulties and obstacles to finish the degree

Nomination Process:

- 1. The student must meet the criteria for nomination.
- 2. The "Statement of Support" must be completed by a member of the ITCD faculty or staff.
- 3. All materials must be completed and submitted by one month before graduation day

How to Nominate:

Faculty Nomination (Faculty or Staff)

1. A member of the ITCD faculty or staff may nominate students by completing the Statement of Support.

Note: For an award nomination to be complete, a Student Nomination Form and a Statement of Support must both be submitted for each nomination.

Recipients of Distinction in the Major for Exemplary Student Achievement will be recognized by the Director of ITCD at the Commencement Awards Ceremony and documented in the students diploma.

The ITCD Faculty and Staff will review all nominations for Distinction in the Major and candidates will be recommended to the Director for approval. The successful candidates will be notified by the ITCD Director's office.
