

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Students who successfully complete the CGE Broward program are eligible for a special \$500 scholarship for the first two consecutive semesters at CSUMB, excluding summer/winter sessions, totaling a \$1,000 scholarship for the first year.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Must carry a minimum 2.0 GPA on university credits (on a 4.0 scale) and a cumulative 2.4 GPA from high school. Applicants will submit Broward and high school transcripts.

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

Students who pass the English Composition I and II courses (transfers as CSUMB A2) while at Universidad San Ignacio de Loyola will meet English Proficiency requirements for admission to CSU Monterey Bay.
