## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Successful completion of the Transfer Pathway program with at least a 2.0 GPA (on a 4.0 scale) will qualify students for admission to CSUMB.

## ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

Students who pass the English Composition I or II courses will meet English Proficiency requirements for admission to CSUMB.
