- Pencils: H, F, HB
- Kneaded eraser
- Hard eraser
- Tracing paper: Canson rolls or pamphlet
- Transfer paper: A little goes a long way, so you may want to wait for the first class to buddy up and share a sheet with others
- Painter's tape or Artist tape
- Watercolor paper: Fabriano or Arches 140 or 300lb hot press or other watercolor paper you are familiar with. Hot press watercolor block is fine.
- Brushes that I could not live without: Sable/Sable blend;(size/shape) 8 round, 4 round, 2 round, 4 flat, 1 inch Hake, old beat up (cheap) synthetic 6 and 4 round for mixing color and misc. uses.
- Watercolor pigments: entry level watercolor set or a grouping of the following colors - Lemon yellow, Van Dyke Brown, Cobalt Blue, Burnt Sienna, Yellow ochre, Phthalo blue, Permanent Red, Quinacridone gold, Permanent white (Winsor Newton gouache).
- *Great colors all things marine: Cobalt turquoise, Emerald
- Watercolor palette if you are using colors from tube
- Container for water
- Paper towels (Viva is best)
- Pencil sharpener
- *Blow dryer
- *Exacto knife
- *Liquid frisket
